

### GENERAL INFORMATION

This Certificate relates only to the condition of the vehicle at the time of testing. It should not be regarded as evidence of the condition of the vehicle at any other time. When you purchase a vehicle you should not regard this Certificate as a warranty. This Certificate does not remove the responsibility from the registered owner to regularly service and maintain the vehicle in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

It is an offence to use on public roads any vehicle which is subject to periodic testing, if an appropriate test certificate is not in force for the vehicle. Therefore a new certificate should be obtained on or before the expiry date above. If the vehicle is to continue in use on the road in Northern Ireland, you should apply for a new certificate at least one month before it is needed, or in the case of a goods vehicle or public service vehicle, six weeks.

You must produce a valid test certificate if asked to do so by a police constable or authorised officer. If you do not produce your certificate, you are liable on conviction to a fine. A valid test certificate must be produced when applying for a vehicle licence. You are therefore advised to keep this certificate readily available while it is in force.

If a certificate is lost or accidentally defaced or destroyed the owner should apply to DVA for a duplicate. A fee will be charged for this service.
